The Government of Mozambique has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Mozambique Urban Transformation Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for the **Downtown Maputo System 1 Drainage Project**.

The Conselho Municipal de Maputo now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for the **Execution of Civil Works for Mitigating Flooding Events in Maputo**. The works under this Contract are going to be developed in the consolidated urban area of Maputo city and include traditional drainage interventions (new stormwater and domestic collectors and runoff collection devices). It also includes centralized linear interventions (collectors), but decentralized solutions, with source control (infiltration trenches/biofilters). It is therefore a hybrid solution (grey and green solutions). These interventions include: (i) Reinforcement of stormwater/unitary sewers (about 12.1km of sewers, with diameters between DN400 and DN1500, and runoff collection devices); (ii) Diversion of stormwater from the upper part of the city directly into Maputo Bay (with three mid-slope sewer systems – CP-GP, CP-SM e CP-MP4); (iii) Reinforcement of domestic wastewater sewers (PTUM) (about 3.2km of sewers, with diameters between DN315 and DN630); (iv) Stormwater source control solutions (execution of 1.15 ha of infiltration trenches).

The main interventions to be undertaken are located in the catchment areas F4 to F9. For a more detailed description of the characteristics of the infrastructures and their locations, please consult the detailed design report and respective drawings.

Bidding will be conducted through international competitive procurement using Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers- Procurement in Investment Projects Financing" dated November 2020 ("Procurement Regulations"), and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.

Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before **31 May 2023, 11.30 hours**, Mozambican time. Electronic Bidding **will not be permitted**. Late Bids **will be rejected**. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the address below on **31 May 2023, 11.30 hours**.

All Bids must be accompanied by a "Bid Security" of **MZN 9,500,000** (nine million, and five hundred thousand meticaís) or equivalent in any freely convertible currency.

All Bids must be accompanied by a Sexual Exploitation and Abuse (SEA) and/or Sexual Harassment (SH) Declaration.

Attention is drawn to the Procurement Regulations requiring the Borrower to disclose information on the successful bidder's beneficial ownership, as part of the Contract Award Notice, using the Beneficial Ownership Disclosure Form as included in the bidding document.
